# State of the Nation

In December 2020 Keep Scotland Beautiful published

**"Time for a new approach to tackling litter"**

Public consultation took place between December 2021 and March 2022

Analysis was published in July 2022.

This is being used in the development of the new Strategy which is due to be published during 2023

# What Does the Data Tell us



**1 in 10 sites have unacceptable levels of litter**

67% of the public believe that litter is a problem in their local area

81% of respondents in the most deprived neighbourhoods report that they often see litter, compared to 68% in the least deprived neighbourhoods

# What Does the Data Tell us



The impact of litter on animals and the environment was deemed the most concerning consequence, followed by the negative perception of an area it creates

4 in 5 people want to see more action taken

50% of people believe overall litter levels have stayed the same in the last 12 months

# What have South Ayrshire Done About this?

- Introduced 4 locality based hit squads
  - 1 team in the South – Maybole, Girvan and outlying areas
  - 2 teams in the North – Ayr, Prestwick, Troon and outlying areas
  - 1 team in Wallacetoun – an area of Ayr with high deprivation
- Working hours of 0745 to 1600 Monday – Thursday and 0745 to 1530 on a Friday

# Equipment



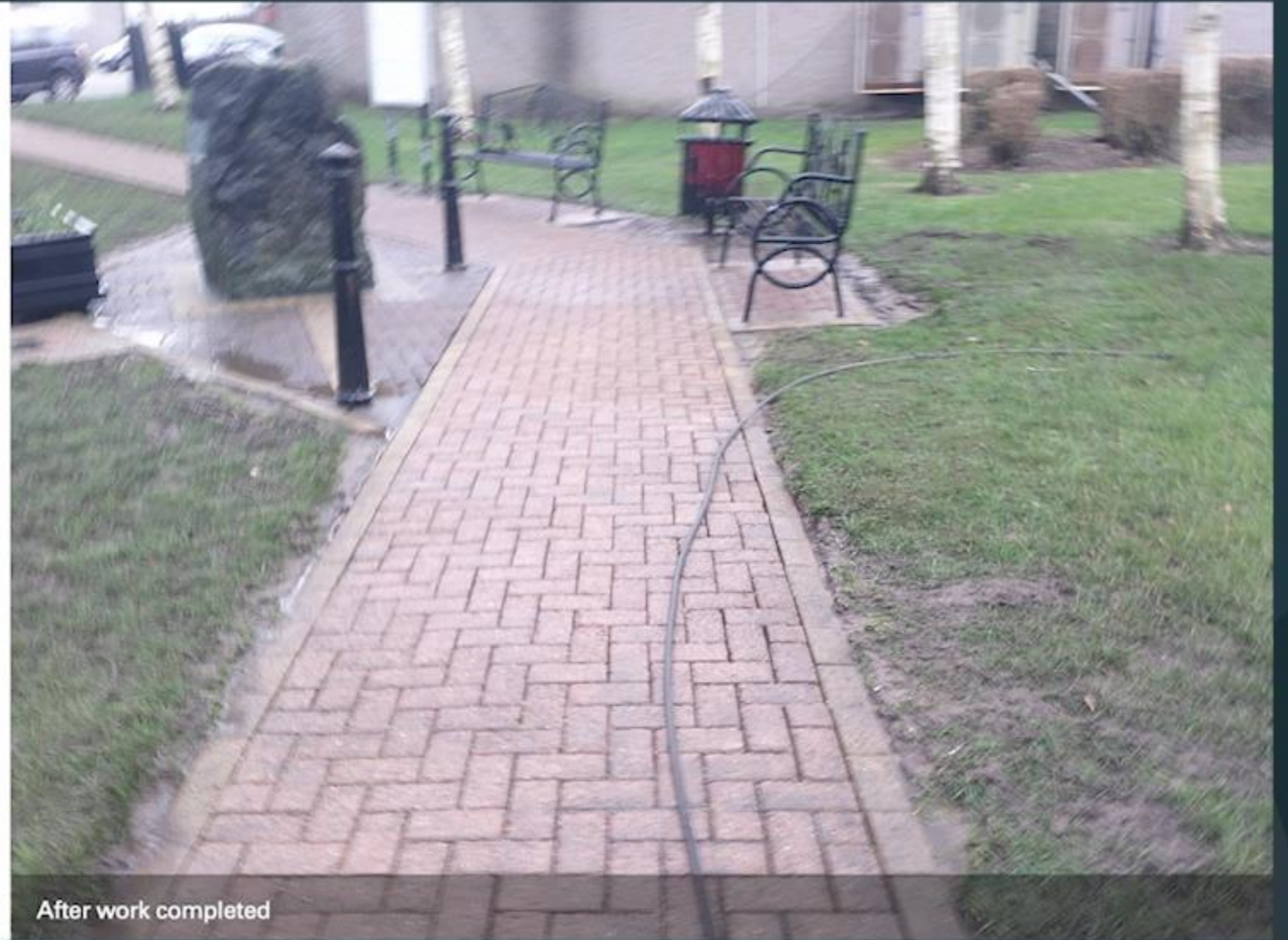
Specialist equipment was purchased to enable a variety of activities to be carried out including litter picking, power washing, weed removal and clearing of fly-tipping.
