






Satisfaction levels vary between services











What buildings does you service clean?






How are cleaning services organised?






Responsibility for other services?






Services outside the LA






Expected growth in the next 12 months






Expected decrease in services






Impact of COVID-19






Measures introduced as a result of COVID-19 - Staffing
