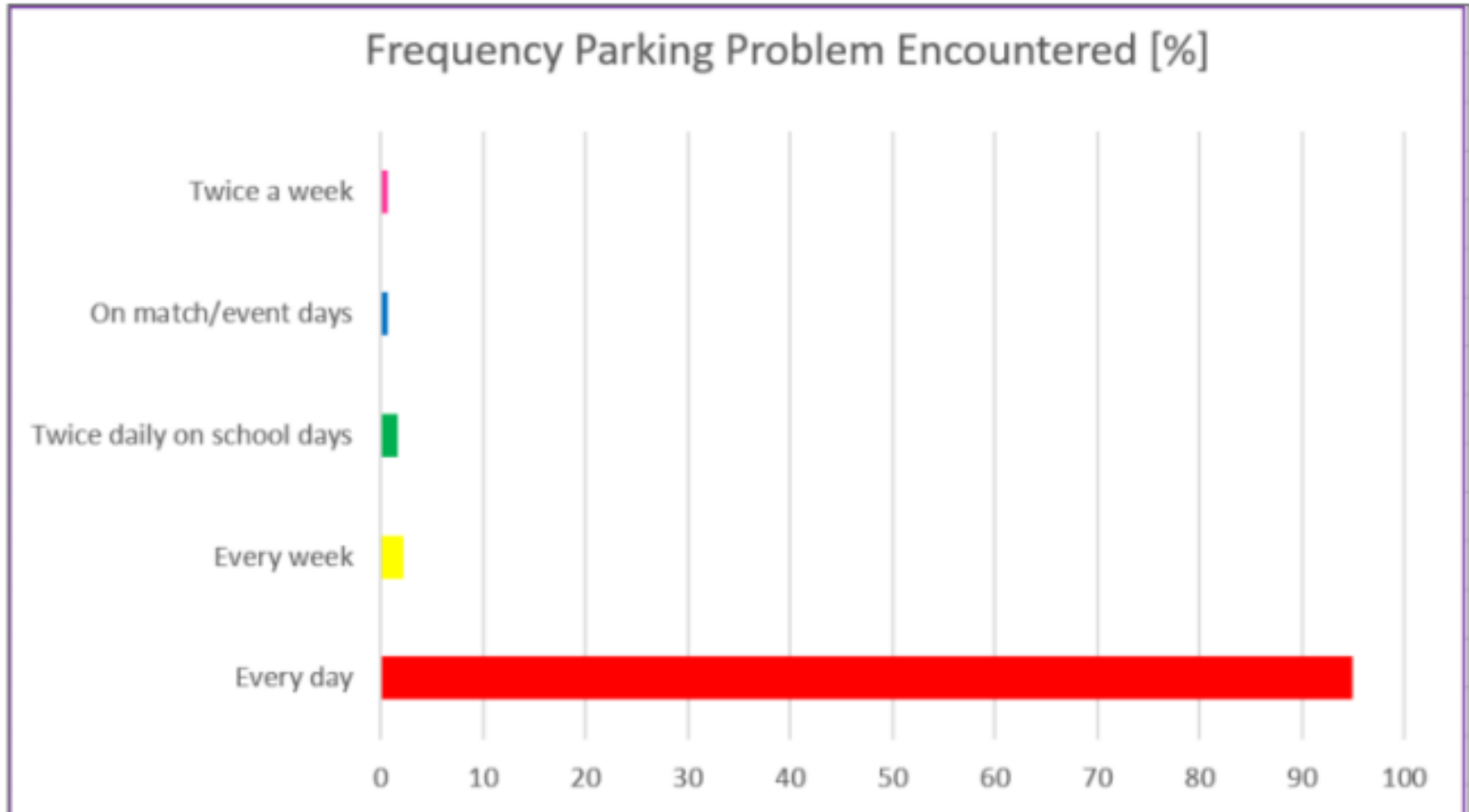
Following consultation in 2017 a consultation analysis report “*Improving Parking in Scotland*” was published in 2018



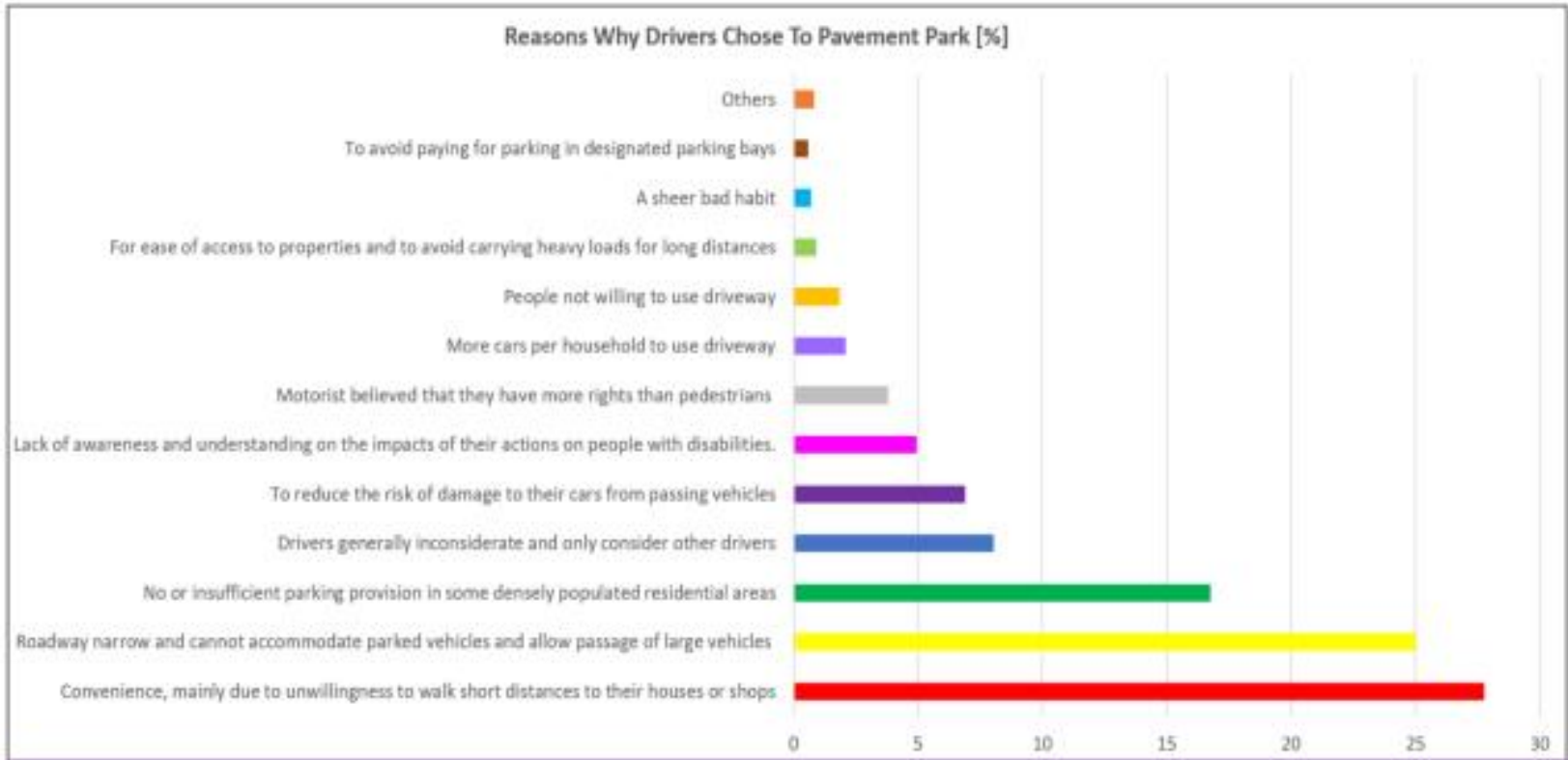

Enforceable under Decriminalised Parking
Enforcement (DPE)

Order laid 2nd October 2023

Requirement on local authorities to;

Identify roads to be exempted

Create exemption TROs

Create enforcement strategy

Challenges for local authorities;

Creation of exemption orders – how to resource assessment, no template

Changes to automated PCN till rolls

Create enforcement strategy – grace period?
