Remobilisation Report – Parks & Open Spaces and Street Cleansing

- APSE has undertaken remobilisation reports for each of the frontline service
- These reports have been complied with the input of local authorities services from across the UK
- Involving an initial scoping report followed by more in depth discussions covering 4 key areas:-
 - Budget, Finance & re-establishing commercial activity
 - Operational activity
 - Re-grouping the workforce
 - Technical issues

Remobilisation Report – Parks & Open Spaces

- During the pandemic parks and open spaces have played a major part in helping individuals meet their physical and mental health needs
- Government have requested these services remain open to avoid a full lockdown similar to other countries including Spain and Italy
- Some facilities within parks and open spaces have been required to close due to the guidance e.g. play areas, out door gyms and toilet facilities
- Some local authorities across the UK have required police assistance during this period to disperse gatherings

Budget, Finance & Re-establishing Commercial Activity

- Impact on chargeable services offered within parks e.g. cafes, car parking, events and other facilities.
- Those with franchises or renting facilities within parks struggling to pay fees.
- Future sustainability of sports clubs such as bowling and football.
- Capital and revenue spend is being closely scrutinised and many non-essential activities are being curtailed or stopped altogether such as spring bulb planting and bedding programmes
- Impact of the COVID-19 response on budgets and finances across the council, increasing costs from measures being brought in to deal with physical distancing and returning services back to "normal" (additional vehicles and staff)



Operational Activity

- Closure of parks facilities and reduced horticultural standards
 - Increasing cut heights of grass
 - Reductions in maintenance of fine turf
 - Closure of bowling greens and golf courses
 - Reduced provision of services in country parks
 - Changing work rotas and moving to single working practices
- Suspension or scaling back of street cleansing
- Biodiversity bonus



Regrouping the workforce


- Redeploying staff back from other services
- Physical distancing measures in place
- Reduced numbers travelling in vehicles
- Rota systems and staggered work times
- Handwashing facilities
- Enhanced risk assessments
- Friends of groups and volunteers not currently working within parks
- Issues with enforcing social distancing by controlling and dispersing gatherings

Technical Considerations

- Time lags in bringing standards of parks back
- Enhanced risk assessments
- Re-opening sports and other physical facilities
- Re-opening of toilet facilities
- Re-opening of play ground and play areas
- Public disposing of personal masks and face coverings and disposable gloves in public bins
