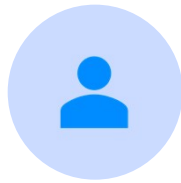

Q: A driver's photocard licence has expired. Can he/she still drive or is there a fine?

A: Normally, there would be a potential fine of up to £1000 for an expired photocard, however due to the current COVID-19 impact there has been an 11 month extension to all expiry dates until the 31st December 2020.



Driving Licence-COVID-19 impact

LOGISTICS UK

- 11 month extension until the 31st December 2020.
Example:
Licence expires 31.10.2020
New expiry date 30.09.2021
- Medicals have been suspended meaning any vocational entitlements are also extended (C1,D1, C, CE, D1).
- **Remember to check both internal company and insurance policies!**
- Expired licences will not be valid in the EU in 2021.



Driver CPC Extensions

For cards that expired from 1st Feb to 31st August 2020, there is an automatic 7 month extension to the expiry date. Driver should carry the expired card to show compliance.

At the end of this extension, drivers must be in possession of their new DQC card. The table to the right shows when the extensions expire.

Expiry Date on Card	Extended Date
February 2020	September 2020
March 2020	October 2020
April 2020	November 2020
May 2020	December 2020
June 2020	January 2021
July 2020	February 2021
August 2020	March 2021
September 2020	September 2020

MOT testing

LOGISTICS UK

Extension for MOTs for light vehicles:

between 30th March and 31st July

vehicles in this period were extended by 6 months.

Either side of this period must be tested before the expiry date.



12-month exemption

Either:

Earned Recognition operator (whole fleet)

Operator in green OCRS roadworthiness band with 50 or more roadworthiness events and a calculated roadworthiness base score of 1.3 or lower on 27th July 2020

Vehicle or trailer up to 2 years old

3-month exemption

Not previously had an exemption and not eligible for a 12-month exemption

Alternatively Fuelled Vehicle

LOGISTICS UK

Under the Category B licence, a driver may operate an alternatively fuelled vehicle up to 4.25 tonnes, providing:

- They have undertaken 5 hours training
- It is used for purpose of transporting goods
- It does not tow a trailer
- It is operated within Great Britain

Trailer unladen weight not exceeding 1020kg for own account



Van: 3.5 tonnes

EXEMPT

NOT EXEMPT

Dual-purpose vehicle

Dual-purpose vehicles at-a-glance:

- constructed or adapted to carry both passengers and goods of any description
- an unladen weight not exceeding 2040kg.
- Four-wheel drive or have the following:
 - Rigid roof with or without a sliding panel
 - Row of upholstered seats behind driver with windows
