Overview of the service

The primary delivery of our Cemeteries Service is divided across two teams:

Place Management Team = 2 dedicated FTE Cemeteries Officers, who are responsible for:

- ➤ Interment Bookings and grave ownership inquiries
- ➤ Masonry Permits and inspections
- > Cemetery Regulations enforcement

Place Operations Team = 5 dedicated FTE Cemeteries Operatives, supported by general grounds maintenance operations, responsible for:

- Preparing graves
- ➤ General grounds maintenance

Infrastructure and tree maintenance are managed by other teams within the council.
