# Bradford JSNA – Our children have the best start in life

In 2016/17 **13.8%** of mothers in Bradford were **Smokers at the Time of Delivery**



Bradford has a higher rate of **Infant Mortality** that both the regional and national average  
**5.9 per 1,000 live births**



The first entrance rate into the **Youth Justice System** in Bradford is **455** per 10,000 10-17 population.

**21.6%** of children aged under 16 live in **low income families**

**67.6%** of children leave reception with a **Good Level of Development**



**570** children in Bradford are subject to a **Child Protection Plan (CPP)**

**31,580** children under 20 in Bradford live in **Low Income Families**  
This is over 20% of all children



**22.5%** of 4-5 year olds and **37.9%** of 10-11 year olds are **Overweight or Obese**

There are **987** **Looked After Children** in Bradford a 6.4% increase since 2017

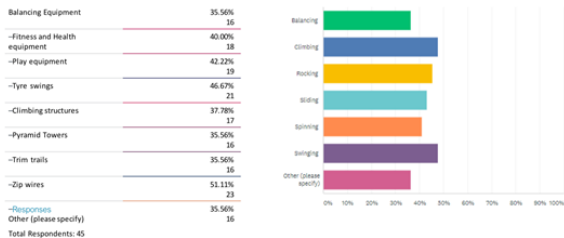
