2012/13 Review of Council Enforcement approach



- Low outputs (90% of previous FPNs issued for vehicle related litter)
- Source of complaints (enforcement perceived to be ineffective as issues such as fly tipping and dog fouling still prevalent; negative media challenges)
- Assumption that FPNs would be issued by PCSO's and park wardens
- Part of £34m efficiency drive dedicated staff reduced





2013/14 Launch of the #BeResponsible Campaign



Tackling dog fouling

- Signage erected on street bins and in parks
- Top Dog Recognition/Reward for responsible behaviour.
 Lots of conversations with dog owners
- Targeted, complaint/evidence enforcement only



- Social media used for the first time on dedicated twitter feed.
- Incident reports reduced by 50% in areas where the campaign was most active

Communities taking back their alleyways...













Love Your Alley greening project – a partnership between Love Old Trafford, Groundwork and the Council

- August-October '16 11 alleyway sections, 308 households
- 7 known as the worse alleyways in Trafford
- Social Value large pharmaceutical firm
- £40K+ funding
- 600 volunteers
- Groundwork commissioned to deliver design and consultation/ engagement works
- Residents encouraged to take part and share ideas at design /implementation phase.

So far so good – the alleys have held!

- 297 BeResponsible events
- 15,500 face to face interactions
- 130 partner agencies
- 400 more businesses complaint with duty of care
- 47% reduction in fly-tipping reports in Clifford Ward
- Supported by community capacity builders in 4 localities bumping spaces for local interest groups to join together

 2015 – Successful launch of the One Trafford Partnership led to 20% operational saving – street cleansing outsourced

Where Next....



- Increase Green Flag parks by 2 per year
- 7 day week shift patterns for street cleansing
- Bar coding litter bins plus £260K investment in on street recycling
- Right Stuff Right Bin Campaign –Additional comms budget (£20K) plus 1 extra Environmental Improvement officer
- Review of One Trafford Partnership key performance indicators (e.g. reduce fly tipping response times)
- Reinvestment of OTP default monies to support In Bloom and other environmental improvements
- #BeBoldBetheDifference (2031 vision)
- Greater use of fly tipping FPNs, CPNs and PSPOs
- Direct action to leverage social value commitments of public sector contractors to support friends groups and Eco Schools
