- Service redesign/ digital



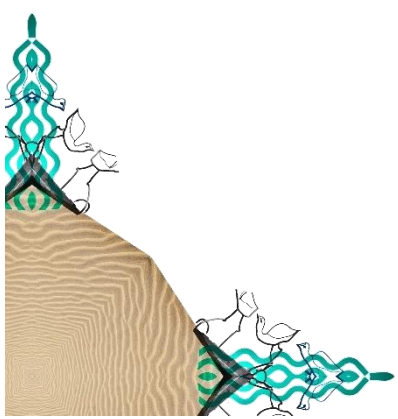
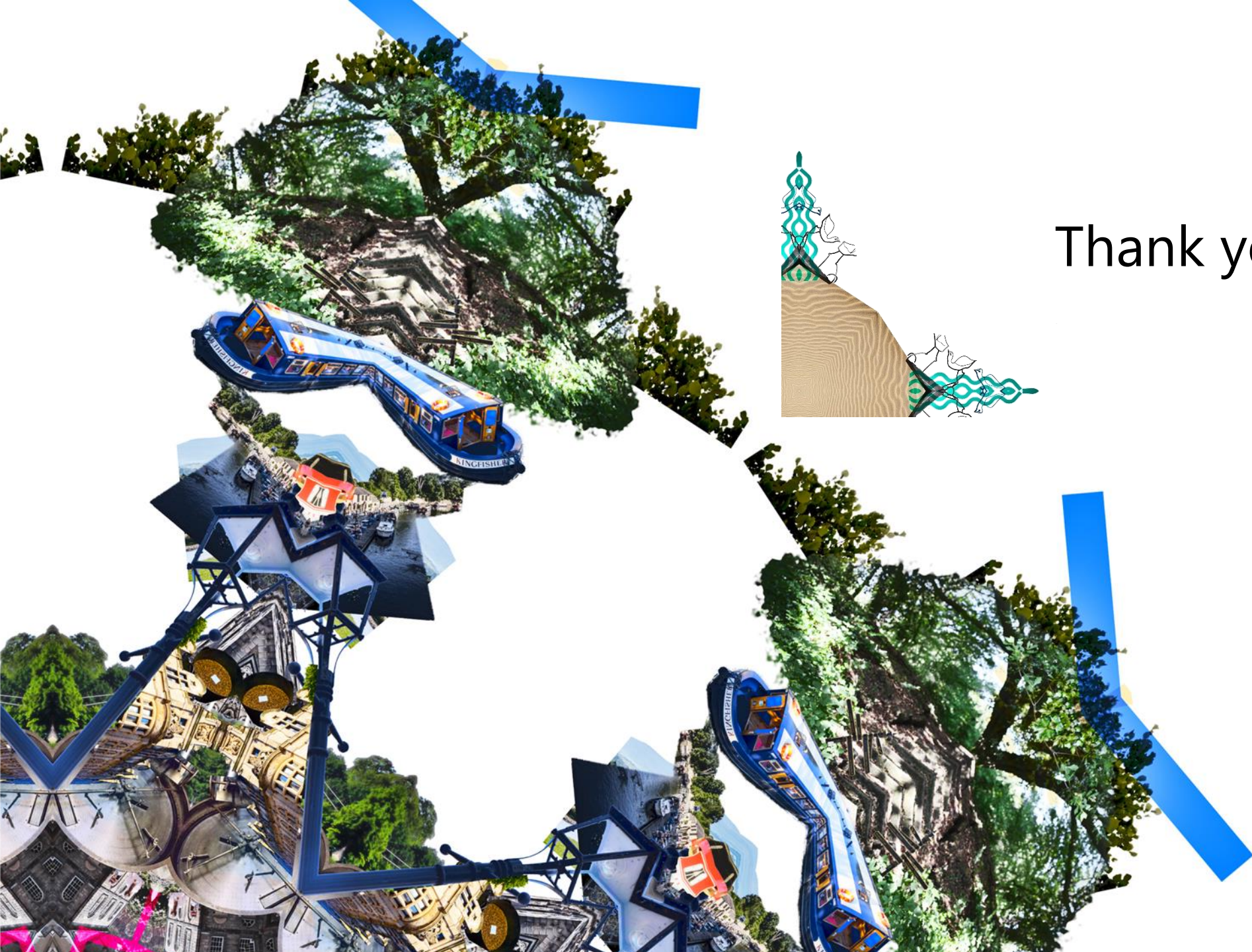
