

WIRRAL COUNCIL - KEY FACTS

- Population approximately 320,000
- Total Area 60 square miles
- 5th Biggest Metropolitan Borough
- Approximately 22,000 high density terraced properties with rear passageways.
- Stark Contrast in Depravation across Borough
 - 11% LSOA's in top 3% nationally
- Clear East / West divide

PERCEPTION vs REALITY

• Wirral commissioned a survey into resident perceptions. Disappointingly, the public perception was found to be very different than the actual reality.

<u>PERCEPTION</u> – 45% THOUGHT LITTER WAS A PROBLEM IN THEIR LOCAL AREA **REALITY** – LEQ SURVEYS CONSISTENTLY RETURN SCORES IN EXCESS OF 92%

<u>PERCEPTION</u> – 56% THOUGHT DOG FOULING WAS A MAJOR PROBLEM

<u>REALITY</u> – VERY LOW INCIDENTS OF DOG FOULING ENCOUNTERED ON LEQ SURVEYS.

KINGDOM SAY ONLY 2 IN EVERY 100 PEOPLE FAIL TO PICK UP AND COMPLIANCE IS BETTER THAT MANY OF THEIR OTHER CONTRACTS.

<u>PERCEPTION</u> – 75% THOUGHT DOG FOULING AND LITTER OFFENDERS SHOULD BE FINED <u>REALITY</u> – WIRRAL HAS ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY TO LITTER AND DOG FOULING. IF YOU ARE CAUGHT YOU WILL BE FINED

<u>PERCEPTION</u> – ONLY 30% OF RESPONDANTS THINK PEOPLE WIL BE CAUGHT OFFENDING

<u>REALITY</u> – KINGDOM WIRRAL HAVE ISSUED OVER 18,000 FPN FOR LITTER SINCE JULY 2015

AND OVER 150 FOR DOG FOULING SINCE JULY 2016



WIRRAL COUNCIL "WIRRAL PLAN" – 2020 PLAN, VISION & STRATEGY DEVELOPMENT

- To create great neighbourhoods where people love to live and fully understand what matters to people about where they live.
- To empower residents to take on more responsibility
- To encourage positive behaviour and provide a clear deterrent against environmental crime.
- To deliver local priorities and address the issues that affect resident's quality of life
- Taking action against environmental crime and antisocial behavior



ENFORCEMENT – TAKE ACTION-PROVIDE DETERRENT...IMPROVE QUALITY OF LIFE

- Decision taken to engage private enforcement
- Wirral Council had tried with limited success
- Needed to tackle all environmental issues
- Litter enforcement chosen as starting point
- Flexible contract Aim was to learn from issues and develop contract.
- Supported with extensive educational campaigns – litter / dog fouling / other



WIRRAL – KINGDOM ENFORCEMENT

- Kingdom Security Ltd successful bidder following tender process
- Contract Commenced July 2015 for 2+1 years
- Litter enforcement was deemed key priority
- Kingdom co-located with WBC
- Extensive marketing and promotions pre-go live
- Message a new "zero tolerance" approach to environmental crime

WIRRAL – KINGDOM LITTER CONTRACT STRUCTURE

- Contract requires minimum of 4800 FPN/PA
- No fixed sum payment process
- Wirral pay Kingdom fixed amount of each paid FPN.
- Where case escalates to court, Kingdom retain agreed payment of initial FPN amount.
- Officer performance appraised through "competency" appraisal following review of total approach to providing the service – appearance, attitude to public, professionalism etc.



WIRRAL - KINGDOM INCOME GENERATION

- Principal aim of Contract is Behavioural Change, Resident Perception and achievement of Wirral Plan.
- Wirral Council surplus circa £ 200k in 15/16.
- Condition of surplus that it is re-invested into Environmental improvements and measures that will achieve Wirral Plan priorities.
- Other areas of enforcement have been introduced and improved through re-investment e.g. Passageway Dumping, Neglected Private land



- Grot Spots / Neglected Private land £40k
- Eliminating Passageway Fly-Tipping £50k
- Dog Fouling Video £5k
- Litter Bins £8k
- "Love Where You Live" volunteer projects –
 equipment & support e.g. Litter Pickers, bags,
 waste collection, etc



WIRRAL – FIXED PENALTY INCOME REINVESTMENT PROJECTS

1. Grot Spots / Neglected Private Land - £40K

- Public perception of "Streetscene" often influenced by land neglect out of Council Control.
- Land Management Clearance provision incorporated into new Graffiti & Fly Posting Contract
- Council used powers under appropriate legislation to require landowners to clear land
- Where non compliance Council clear and apply land charges.
- Public informed of progress and success through media and social media feedback

WIRRAL – FIXED PENALTY INCOME REINVESTMENT PROJECTS

2. Eliminating Passageway Fly-Tipping - £ 50k

- Poor and incorrect presentation of waste in passageway areas has been longstanding blight.
- Affects quality of life for local residents increases smells, pests and vermin.
- Impacts on correct waste storage, presentation and collection, which in turn affects recycling.
- Costs additional £500,000 in cleansing resource.
- New Kingdom team established to tackle resident behaviour face to face and issue on the spot FPN for offences.



2. Eliminating Passageway Fly-Tipping - £ 50k

- 3. Dog Fouling Enforcement Campaign Video £5k
- Used to support introduction of "zero tolerance "approach to dog fouling FPN's by Kingdom.
- Professionally Commissioned video through local company
- Features local people and community organisations
- Published extensively on social media





WIRRAL – KINGDOM – CONCLUSIONS & FUTURE DEVELOPMENT

- Decision on contract extension agreed in principle. (1 year).
- Other Enforcement Opportunities parking, waste services, pavement licenses etc.
- Overall hugely successful model with political support and comfort.
- Now starting to see defined improvements in LEQ.
- Press no longer interested in sensationalism.
