Nicky Joiner, Area Catering Co-ordinator, East Renfrewshire Council provided a comprehensive and informative presentation on their Best Performer Catering award in APSE Performance Networks.

The presentation included information on what East Renfrewshire were doing with Free School Meals and School Meals uptake.

Nicky highlighted that there was a 35% increase in business if the Council put on a buffet day, which was also a great way for the kids to get involved in the lunch choices. The buffet days were a hit with both catering staff and school children.

Nicky also spoke about the Councils Primary One lunch service. This was a restaurant style – soup on the table, staff serve main meals, desserts on table. This took away the risk of young children having accidents as they didn't have to balance trays, purses and personal items.

The presentation also included information on how the Council dealt with absence management and staff reductions concluding with some of the future investments/initiatives they would be looking to work towards within the service.
