



Over 800 green spaces across 4000 hectares including...

- 13 city parks (Hillsborough Park is one)
- 20 district parks
- 50 local parks
- 342 local green spaces
- 181 woodlands
- 81 allotment sites
- 262 Nature Conservation sites
- 150 playgrounds
- Part of Sheffield's region is within the Peak District boundary

Tired tennis courts and a dilapidated games area in a popular Sheffield park are to be revamped with a new activity hub.






Timeline of a Coach House Cafe





- Running sessions at a number of parks
- Wanting a stronger presence and more organisational 'resilience' in Sheffield.
- 2016/17 approach P&C about a dementia café in the coach house
- Who to talk to? P&C, Planning, Property, Legal. Also Charity Commission & funders
- 2017/18: Development phase (SCC providing a 'letter of comfort' to enable fundraising)
- 2017/18: Project Board established
- 2018/19: Heritage Fund feasibility grant (and Architectural Heritage Fund).
- **2020/21**: Plans and vision evolved (Friends, Rivelin Co and P&C Service). The Gathering Ground concept emerged. Things stalled a bit at this stage...
 - Development plans now included restoration of the potting shed and Coach House walled garden link.
 - Proposal approved in via Cabinet report awarding AgeUK Sheffield 125 year lease.
 - Round 2 Heritage Grant Award £631k

1.3 Project Funding

The project was awarded £631,200 of development funding from the National Lottery Heritage Fund (NLHF), which was a 60% NLHF grant. The remaining 40% of the funding was secured from the following sources:

- Age UK Sheffield Reserves £100K
- The Bradbury Foundation £100K
- Wolfson Foundation £80k
- Garfield Weston Foundation £40k
- Bernard Sunley Foundation £20k
- Clothworkers Foundation £75k




Forward Plan Consultation 2021

The online consultation had 412 responses and identified key themes and local priorities for investment across the site.

The following items were almost universally scored as poor:

- Lack of visitor facilities especially toilet and café,
- Drainage
- Underinvestment in sports facilities
- Condition of the Lake, wildfowl and illegal fishing
- Communication and community
 engagement
- Signage and notice boards
- Interpretation about the history of the park,
- Lighting (evening safety)
- Derelict buildings / lodge



Consultation Results identified many areas for improvement – key concerns would be addressed through 2022:

- Café and toilet facilities at the Coach House
- Improved drainage and path networks
- Better information and heritage interpretation.
- Pump track investment

Consultation responses highlighted the potential to be a **highly accessible park** and community resource and its importance to visitors' mental and physical well-being.

Outcomes

- Eye sore now a true heritage asset, plus:
 - Income generate
 - Public access facility
 - Heritage Interpretation
 - Wee & and a Tea
- 900 people in Activity Plan related events and activities
- Restoration of the Walled Garden Potting Sheds
 - Public access facility
 - Venue for community activity
- Creation of the Gathering Ground including the Pavilion management
- Permanent partnership with RivelinCo
 started as delivering the Activity Plan
- Increased resilience of Age UK Sheffield
- 19 people employed at the Coach House
- A catalyst for Park revitalisation



Café: Post completion user survey:

- 100% of respondents this has improved the local area
- 81% said they would spend more time in the park now the café has opened










Proposed £1.3m Multi-Activity Hub: Gathering Ground for sports & recreation
