

Local solutions for cleaner, safer neighbourhoods – fly tipping

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Background

- 2022 Council identified tackling fly tipping as a priority
- Move to zero tolerance approach to enforcement, away from education and advice
- Restructure to integrate the neighbourhood team into the enforcement team
- Close working with partners; Operations and Greenspace, Legal, Waste Services, Community Safety, CCTV and Greater Manchester Police

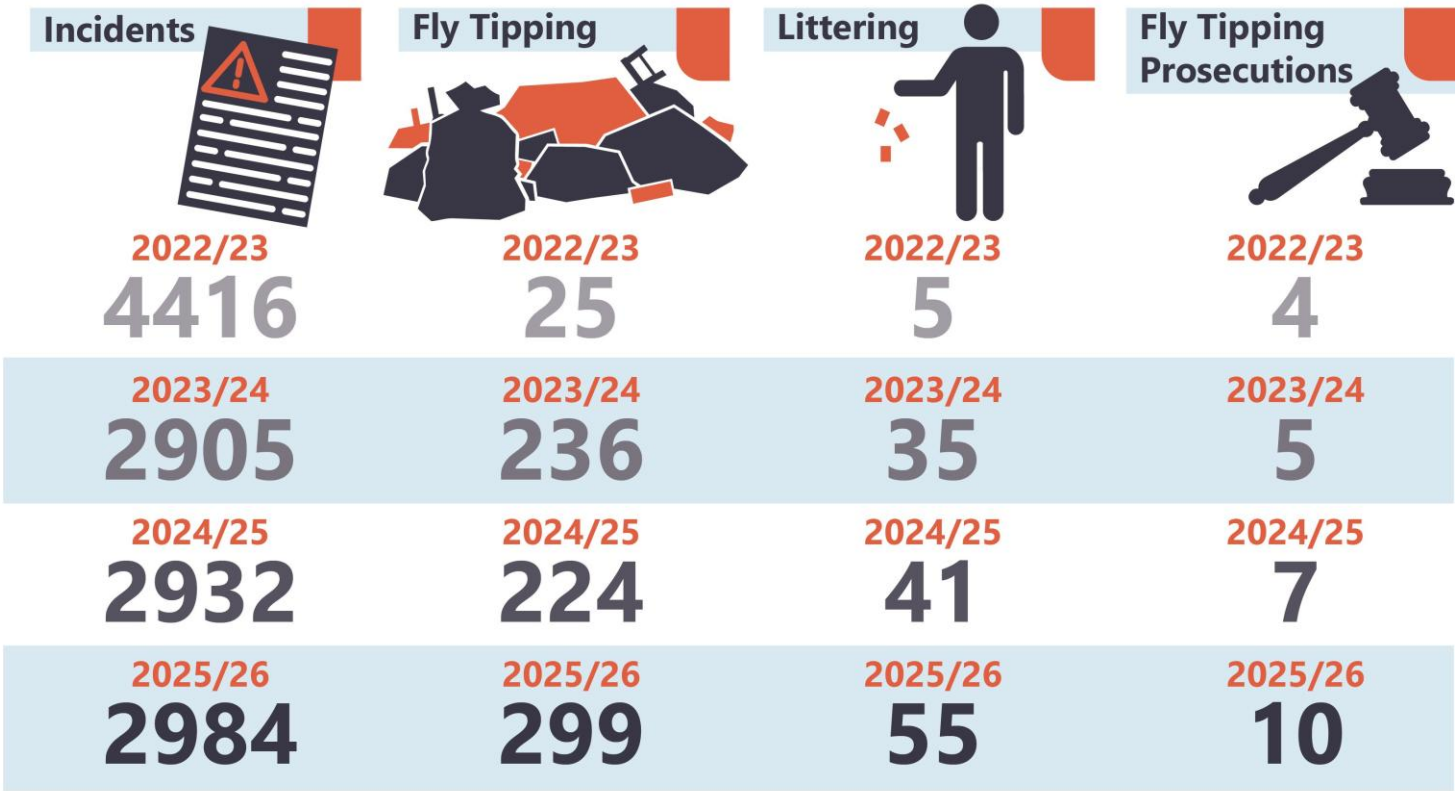
How

- Co-produced process across various teams to identify how fly tipping reports would be triaged and dealt with
- Training across all teams and seminars with cleansing and enforcement teams
- Launched 'Our Streets' communications campaign
- Days of action – initially focussed around town centres to raise profile. Now demand led in hotspot areas – involving local schools and community safety team

Challenges

- Issues with CRM system

Teams develop pride and responsibility for specific towns, fostering accountability and proactive work

Teams identify and collate evidence

Report other street scene issues: overflowing litter bins (Duty of Care), street furniture, contaminated bins
