

- December 2005: Surplus to requirements
- May 2006: Last tenant re-housed
- Option Appraisal Process: demolish, sell or refurbish ???

Funding available

Department of Health Extra Care Housing Funding: £80m Nationally

MCC/NH joint bid submitted May 2008; approved July 2008

2nd biggest allocation nationally of £6.54m


Total refurbishment cost (incl fees) of £8.9m



25% payment from DoH on achievement of each milestone (therefore full allocation secured)


