5. Health & Safety: Vehicle Reversing Managing after an Incident

Speaker: Ronnie Dempster, Head of Service, Dumfries & Galloway Council

Ronnie provided a comprehensive presentation on Health & Safety management after an accident. A detailed discussion followed on driver reversing and also the role of the cameras.

6. Contribution to Sustainable Transport: Glasgow City Council

Speaker: Gavin Slater, Principal Officer Carbon Management Team, Glasgow City Council

Gavin provided a detailed presentation on the use of electric vehicles. Highlighting the reasons for using electric vehicles including climate change targets. Gavin also informed the group of Glasgow's aim to be the most sustainable city in Europe within the next 20 years.

It was highlighted that Scottish Government was in full support for the electric vehicle programme, providing help through Plugged-In Places and the procurement support scheme.

Gavin concluded by providing some of the benefits to the electric vehicle scheme of Glasgow City Council, these included:-

- Localised air quality improvements
- Showacase Glasgow as a forward thinking City
- Help achieve the climate change and low carbon reduction targets
- Delivery of the lowest carbon games
- Reduction in fuel consumption and emissions from internal vehicle fleet

Dave provided the group with a detailed presentation on how Renfrewshire Council had achieved finalist & winner status of the APSE performance Networks awards.
