Putting together a Project



Funding Package

- Loans
- Incentives and/or grants and/or subsidies
- Procurement costs

Contracts

- Works Contract Design consultancy? Construction? Design and Build?
- Maintenance contracts
- Funding Agreements
- Offtake Agreement (PPA)
- Grid Connection Agreements
- Leases (75 years +)

Other

- Procurement documents / Approvals processes
- Financial Model
- Stakeholder engagement







Self-Managed Projects





- Authority will need to procure contracts, arrange funding, agree the grid connection, consult with stakeholders and bear the commercial risk.
- Issues for the Authority:
 - Procurement costs
 - Resources and expertise
 - Risk appetite
- Best option for this model is to collaborate with other authorities and form a joint venture to share the
 costs and resources
 APSE strategic legal partner







Developer - Led Projects



- This was the easiest option for authorities as no EU compliant tender process was required.
- The developer was leased the site with an option to develop for hydro.
 The authority was paid a rent plus a return based on the energy generated.
- With reductions in FITs, this approach is <u>unlikely to be commercially</u> <u>viable for developers</u> – the projects will not generate a sufficient return on investment for their funders.



Partnership Model



– The Authority brings:

- Land
- Offtake Agreement
- Funding public works loans

– The Developer brings:

- Contracts Design and construction contracts procurement
- Maintenance management
- Grid connection
- Expertise in project delivery
- Stakeholder engagement
- Funding
- Risk transfer







What about the EU Procurement Rulesse



- The partnership model is likely to fall under the EU procurement rules.
- The importance of efficient procurement processes:
 - Market test your proposal
 - Keep your documents simple
 - Down-select early and aggressively
 - Award within 4-5 months
 - Understand and project manage around approvals processes
- Collaborate with other authorities set up a framework to manage costs
