Municipal Waste Systems are Fragmented and Frustrating to Use

- Users are forced to utilize 3-7 systems
- Overcomplicated software
- Not able to integrate with third-party software
- Beavy and lengthy manual processes
- S Low transparency between stakeholders



BACKGROUND	CHALLENGES	OUTCOMES
Manages a team of 70 employees	Employees frustrated by working with outdated and clunky systems	Happy employees using a user-friendly platform customized to the precise need of Fredericia
Collecting household and commercial waste	No ownership over waste data	Waste & fleet data consolidated in one platform to inform data-driven decision- making
Waste is collected in-house, with a private hauler responsible for some fractions	Lack of transparency, documentation, and digitalisation.	Digital work tools for every employee. Nov able to document, for example, skipped bin collections
Own two recycling stations and one landfill area	An ineffective and decentralised approach to waste collection and handling	Efficient routing, centralised approach to operations, real-time data insights



Pressure on Back Office

- Using multiple systems that can't integrate
- Local authorities struggling to meet new requirements with old systems
- Employees are frustrated with paperbased processes and old, clunky systems
- Retaining employees
- Driver shortages •
- Long time to train new drivers



Food Waste Legislation

- Incoming legislation to collect food waste every week
- How to design efficient rounds to align with requirements
- How to effectively engage citizens regarding changes



Addressing the Green Agenda

- How to redesign rounds to decrease fuel usage without compromising service for citizens
- How to boost recycling rates and engage citizens



Budget Cuts

- Pressure to cut costs across operations
- Subscription costs for multiple software packages
- Wages for frontline and back office staff
- Redesigning rounds for cost-effective operations (drivers, vehicles)
- High cost of diesel
- Vehicle maintenance
