A summary of the submissions

- Leicester 'Kick it to plastics' environmental arts project to raise awareness and get greater community buy-in to reducing plastic waste.
- Daventry '123 Waste Service' returning service in-house and total re-design of recycling collections with significant increases in recycling rates and reductions in residual waste.
- Newcastle **Wastebot** digitisation of permits and other waste associated information to use HWRC's. Improved customer experience and administrative/operational processes.


A summary of the submissions

- Newcastle Smart Litter Bins litter bins fitted with fill sensors allowed route optimisation, job creation and scheduling, real time reporting schedules resulting in 50% reduction in bin emptyings.
- Kettering and Corby '**Flymapper'** identification of areas prone to flytipping and carried out analysis (date, time, typological relationships) leading to better detection and prevention of flytipping. Prosecutions and 20% reduction in incidents.
- Cornwall Community Enforcement Partnership Programme fly-tipping, littering and dog-fouling identified as major problems in local areas. Communities, elected members developed partnership approach and staff trained in enforcement. Significant reductions have resulted.
- Liverpool **Creating the Site Enhancement Team** On street living, begging etc. having significant adverse impact on streetscene quality and costs. Partnership approach to targeted cleaning and support to get people off streets has led to significant success.
