

Wigan Council Fleet Cost Savings Project

Historic vehicle and plant damage costs



- From April 1 2013 to 28 February 2014 (11 months) there were a total of 1,176 incidents in the fleet with a basic cost of £197,491 and £152,511 3rd party insurance claims
- 569 avoidable incidents costing £90,173. An average of 52 per month and £158 per incident
- 120 minor collisions costing £33,764. An average of 11 per month and £281 per minor collision
- 410 repairs costing £73,555. An average of 37 per month and £179 per repair
- 77 insurance claims costing £52,511. An average of £682 per claim. With a further £102,00 currently accrued

Total 1,176 incidents at £350,002

What we committed to deliver in March 2014



- Recruit a Fleet and Driver Standards Officer
- Start to engage our drivers in the future change requirements
- Recruit Fleet Information Officer to develop robust systems to capture more accurate data and improve our overall communication systems
- Develop training programs to aid our delivery
- Reduce our Fleet overall costs both in terms of fuel usage and vehicle damage
- Introduce revised driver booklet and fleet strategy policies


