



Downside of a sticker based system

'Substandard' stickers delay garden waste scheme

Repeat requests

We normally only allow one replacement sticker request per subscription.

If you need to order replacement sticker(s) more than once we will contact you to discuss your situation.

Those who paid were sent tamper-proof labels for their bins but several residents took to social media to claim the ones they received were already peeling off.

Downside of a sticker based system








Disadvantages



- High costs for purchasing and distributing resistant, weatherproof stickers every year
- Stickers are open to manipulation from residents claims for not having received the sticker or reporting bin as being stolen but instead using it for a second container
- Lack of clarity regarding missed bin collection leading to complaints and a missed bin second run
- No easy way of removing weatherproof sticker at the end of the season
- Need to train the residents placing the sticker correctly on the bin

Fully digital garden waste scheme

Digital process



Digital solution



- Chip bins with RFID transponder
- No need for label stickers any more
- No action from resident required to correctly place a sticker on the bin
- No cheating possible
- No active sticker checking from the collection team on the round
- No high recurring annual costs
- Full overview about collected bins and missed bins in "real-time"
- Stolen / appropriated bins can be "blacklisted" and blocked from collection easily

Financial Return Illustration



- 10,000 bins in total
- Fortnightly collection cycle
- 1,000 bins per collection round
- 1 identification system (on collection vehicle)

- ➤ Annual costs for stickers: £30,000
- Investment digital system: ca. £55,000 for retrofitting bins, vehicle equipment, software in 1. year
- Annual costs: ca. £8,000 for maintenance and licences
- > Return on investment: ca. 2.5 years
- Yearly savings: £22,000



c-ident with touch panel

- Collection team can directly see the reason for lift stop
- Only registered bins are emptied
- Possibility to override blocked emptying if requested
- Recording of special events by simply pressing a button
